There is a wide variety of players at Calvary so teams will be balanced according to the total ability of the team to score. This will be done before the tournament so be sure to note your golfing ability when you register.

Rules for This Year's Best Ball C.C.C.B. Golf Tournament

1. Each threesomes, foursome, or five some has to use 3 tee shots by each player
2. Each player tees off and the team selects the best shot location and then each player plays from that spot
3. Play continues with all team players shooting from the position of the best shot until someone holes out
4. Players can move golf ball 1 club length at any time on the fairway or rough but no closer to the hole.
5. Balls in bunkers cannot be moved, but no more than two strokes/bunker will be counted on the score
6. Lost Ball, out of Bounds, or in water-- add 1 stroke to score
7. Long drive must be in bounds and not in a water hazard
8. Maximum Strokes per hole: 8 On Par 4 Holes, and 6 on Par 3 Holes
9. In case of a tied team score we will revert back to the first hole for the lowest score.
